Presentació

Specialization course focused on exploring qualitative research methods in Arts-Based Research paradigm, in order to provide theoretical and practical tools for students to design their doctoral projects in Arts, Humanities, Social Sciences and Technology always related with arts. Total of 20 ECTs.

For arts-based research, the course includes all subgenres considered in contemporary scholarship: Design-Based Research, Performance, Poetry, Theatre, Visual Arts, Arts-based educational research (ABER), A/R/Tography, etc. (Barone & Eisner, 1997; Frayling, 1994; Irwin, 2008; Leavy, 2015, 2019; among others).

Objectius

- Introduce students to scientific and artistic research.
- Offer specialized training in Arts-Based Research, applied in the following areas/disciplines: interaction design, human-computer interaction, design research, visual arts, performing arts, arts education, and education.
- Give tools to design a viable doctoral research project in Arts, Humanities, Social Sciences and Technology.
- Accompany students in the design of their doctoral research projects.
- Contribute to the integration of newly arrived students in the local, national and international academic community, especially the European academic context.

ATTENTION! The approval in this Specialization course DOES NOT imply acceptance of the student at their aimed PhD program and university. After concluding the course, students must apply for themselves for their intended doctoral programs, following the selection protocols of each university and its respective PhD programs' formal requisites. These selection processes and protocols are independent of this Specialization course diploma.

The PhD plan will be evaluated according to the following notes:

Excellent/Outstanding (9 -10) - The research plan is clear, consistent and coherent. It formulates high-level inquiry questions, objectives and approaches. It presents a solid theoretical and methodological framework as well as an excellent formal structure, following all the necessary topics of a rigorous research design plan. Likewise, it is written with the correct use of English, a formal academic style, and APA norms.

Good/Commendable (7 - 8.9) - The research plan is well written and formulated. It notably demonstrates the student academic and scientific skills, as well as their basic knowledge of the theme, problems and inquiries. The ideas are very well formulated, but the plan lacks in academic rigor and style.

Pass (5 - 6.9) - The research plan demonstrates the student's progress and scientific basic skills, but it does not achieve the quality demanded and trained during the course.

Fail (0 - 4.9) - The work does not present the minimum standards and requisites of an academic work.

His research explores how to design everyday technology that fosters a playful attitude towards mundane activities to respond to people's social-emotional needs. Ferran has extensive academic and practical experience in the areas of interaction design, participatory innovation, design methods, playful technology and human-food interaction. Since 2021 he has a doctorate in Computational Media from the University of California, Santa Cruz. Previously, he graduated in Audiovisuals and Multimedia and Interactive Design from the University of Girona (Catalonia) and the University of Lincoln (UK). He also has an MSc in IT Product Design from the University of Southern Denmark, where he specialized in participatory innovation. He has also completed shorter stays at other institutions such as Carnegie Mellon University (USA), PHL Hasselt (Belgium) and TU/e Eindhoven (Holland), and has been a professor of design at Designskolen Kolding (Denmark) and at the ERAM University School (Catalonia). In general, Ferran investigates the applied, theoretical and methodological aspects of interactive technology design.
